

Ticket Information

- Tickets will be sold **March 20-22 and 25-29 for \$40.00 each.**
- Tickets will not be sold to any WHS students if they owe money to the school.
- Tickets will not be sold to juniors or issued to seniors if the participation contract is not returned with parent signatures.
- Senior tickets are free, but tickets will not be issued to seniors who owe money to the school.
- Students must be in compliance with attendance and the SDOC behavior code.
- Tickets WILL NOT BE SOLD OR ISSUED at the door.

Date Approval Form

- If you are planning to bring a guest from another school or a guest who is in 9th or 10th grade at WHS, you must submit the Date Approval form.
- Guest tickets cannot be purchased before the Date Approval form has been processed.

- Forms will be available in the library. Please select the correct form -- #1

for WHS/WOHS/SHS students, #2 for all other schools.

- Completed forms should be submitted **to the library** by **March 22**. Form

#1 goes to our front office, and form #2 goes to guest's school to be

completed and FAXED to our front office.

Dress Code

The purpose of a prom dress code is to keep the focus of the night on making memories with friends and provide an appropriate, comfortable environment for all students and staff attending the event.

Prom Dress Code

The Senior Prom is a formal affair; therefore, the

attendees

should dress accordingly.

Attire that does not meet the dress code will result in being

denied entrance to prom without a refund for ticket purchase.

Temporary pinning is not allowed as an alteration for a dress

if it does not meet the dress code. Cover-ups will not be

allowed over dresses that do not meet the dress code.

Prom Dress Code - If you are wearing a dress...

- Dresses should be an appropriate length and no shorter than

three (3) inches above the knee.

- Slits should begin at fingertip length or below.
- For dresses with a sheer overlay, the part under the sheer overlay must be at least fingertip length.
- High-low dresses should have a front hem of three (3) inches above the knee or longer.
- Two-piece dresses are allowed with two (2) inches or fewer of midriff exposed. Belly buttons should be covered.

Prom Dress Code, continued...

- Dresses must not be cut below the bust line. Plunging necklines

(even with sheer illusion fabric) and cut-outs in the bust are not

appropriate.

- Dress may be backless, but they should be at the natural waist or

higher, and they should have an established side (no deep side

cut-outs).

- If your dress is sheer anywhere (skirt, top, illusion fabric, etc.), the

part underneath must meet dress code on its own.

Avoid These Styles

Prom Dress Code - If you're wearing a suit/t

- Tuxedos, nice suits, or sport coats with dress pants should be worn with a dress shirt and tie.
- A tie is required.
- Western tuxedos and suits may be worn with dress boots.
- No jeans are allowed.
